**ORDER**

On review of the record, the Court determined that its subject matter jurisdiction was unclear. On March 14, 2024, the Court issued an Order requiring the parties to confer and brief the issue. [Doc. No. 79]. Before the Court is a Notice in which the parties agree that the Court lacks subject matter jurisdiction. [Doc. No. 80].

Under 28 U.S.C. § 1447(c) and the parties' Notice, the Court finds that it lacks subject matter jurisdiction. Accordingly, the Court REMANDS the action under § 1447(c) to the District Court of Oklahoma County, State of Oklahoma, Case No. CJ-2022-5078, for further proceedings. The parties shall bear their own attorney's fees, costs, and expenses related to the removal and remand.
